- It is important to know what to do if you have concerns about an illness during this outbreak. The Warren County Health Department encourages those who may be at risk for COVID-19, to utilize the Missouri Coronavirus hotline 877-435-8411 or call their health care provider to inform them of their travel history and symptoms. You will be instructed on how to receive care without exposing others to the possible illness.”
- Testing is NOT available at the Warren County Health Department.

Simple preventive actions that help prevent the spread of all types of respiratory viruses include:

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Cover your mouth/nose with a tissue or sleeve when coughing or sneezing
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol if soap and water are not available.

Office relocations can be the catalyst for giving your entire company a make-over.

Cutting down on costs


