LICENSE OFFICE HAS REOPENED ON LIMITED BASIS

As concerns with COVID-19/Corona Virus continue, we want to stress that taking care of our customers and staff is of the utmost importance to us. The Warrenton License Office will reopen on a modified schedule to serve our community while implementing the following procedures to comply with the guidance of the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and the State:

- Only 1 customer per transaction will be allowed entrance into the License Office. At this time, we have only one clerk so only one person will be permitted in the License Office at any given time.
- Countertops and pens will be disinfected in between each customer.

We will continue to monitor conditions and will assess our response and operations daily.

We remain committed to controlling what we can to best serve our customers and community. We ask that if you are feeling ill or have a fever to please not come to the office.

There will be no new or renewed Driver's Licenses available to process at this time.

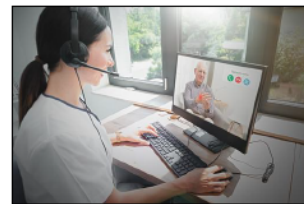
How does it work?
